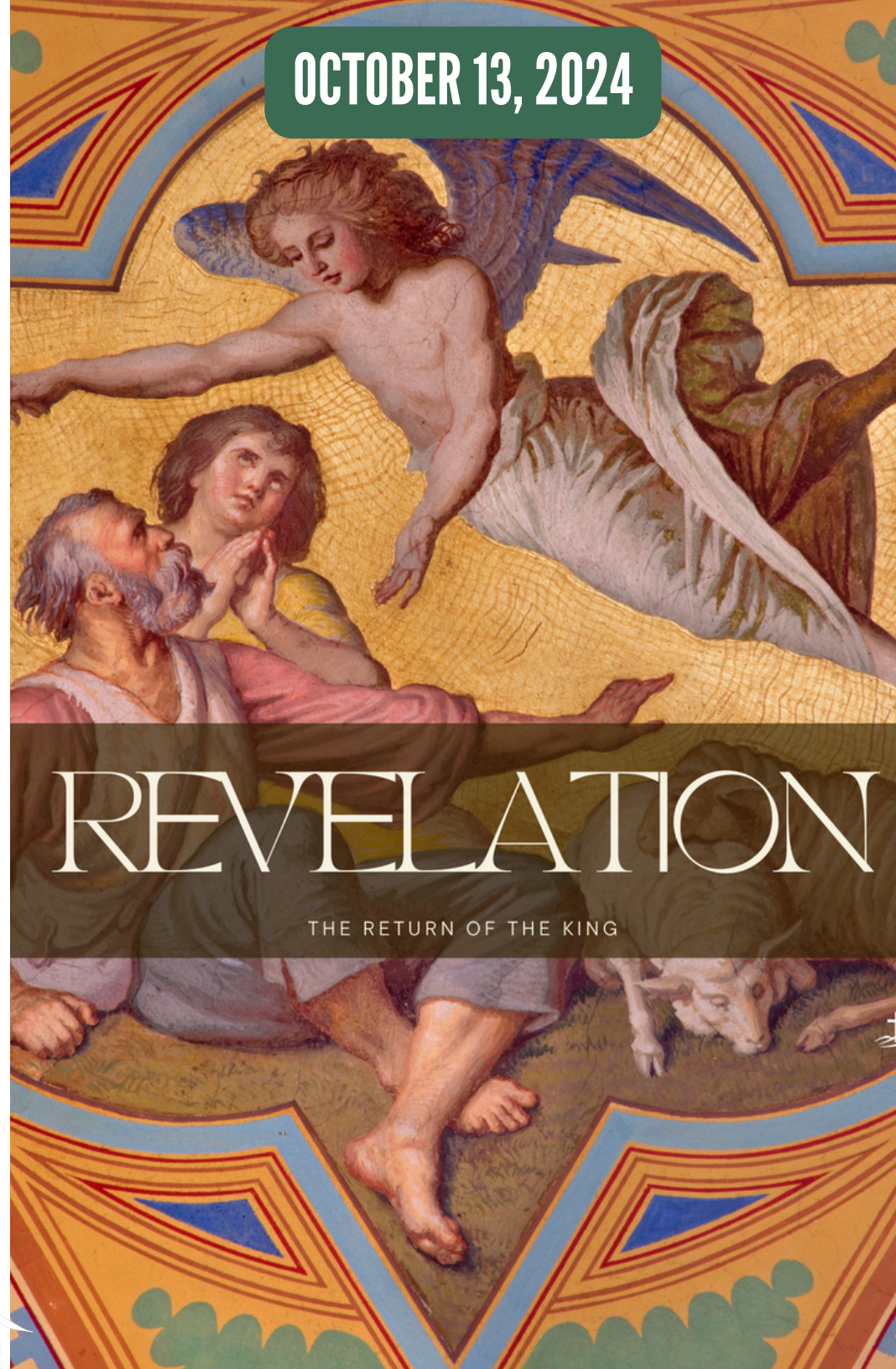

THE GOSPEL

THE CENTER OF EVERYTHING WE DO AT HIGHLANDS

GOD: The only all-knowing, all-powerful King and Creator of all things. He created us to enjoy and glorify him forever. [Psalm 19:1-2; Romans 1:18-32]

SIN: Yet, we rejected God, and established ourselves as gods of our lives, separating ourselves from Him, and becoming objects of His wrath. In so doing we also unleashed sin, sickness, death and evil. [Ephesians 2:1-3; Romans 5:12-14]

CHRIST: In God's unparalleled mercy and grace, He already had a plan to reconcile us to Himself. The entire Old Testament points to the coming of the Messiah - revealed in the New Testament as Jesus Christ. [John 1; Ephesians 2:4-7; Romans 3:21-26]

RESPONSE: None of this is effective for us unless we respond in two ways: repent/turn from our self control and sin [Mark 1:15], and believe in the gospel [John 3:16-18]. We are then given new life in Christ, forgiven, justified, adopted into God's family, and we persevere in the faith. [1 John 1:9; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Matthew 24:13; Ephesians 4:1]

- Read Psalm 139:22-24. What is frightening about these verses? How can we actually pray this way?
- What is difficult to believe about God judging sin in real tangible ways?
- Where can people try and overcomplicate the faith to justify sin?

SERMON NOTES

Revelation 2:18-29 | Letter to Thyatira

1. Good News and Bad News [2:18-20; 1:14b-15; James 2:14-17; Ephesians 2:8-10; Ecclesiastes 10:1]

The church needs both good works and good doctrine.

2. Hearts and Minds [2:21-23; Psalm 32:1-4; 31:10; Jeremiah 17:10; 1 Corinthians 11:27-30; Psalm 139:23-24; 26:2; Romans 2:1-5; Hebrews 12:7; Romans 8:1]

Jesus sees and eventually judges all sin.

3. Iron Rods, Clay Pots, and Moring Stars [2:24-29; Psalm 2:8-9; Revelation 2:7; 2:10; 2:17]

Simple faithfulness will earn extraordinary rewards.

Big Idea: We are called to conquer sin, not have sin conquer us.
