

THE GOSPEL

THE CENTER OF EVERYTHING WE DO AT HIGHLANDS

GOD: The only all-knowing, all-powerful King and Creator of all things. He created us to enjoy and glorify him forever. [Psalm 19:1-2; Romans 1:18-32]

1. Induce Vomiting [3:14-16; 2 Corinthians 1:20; John 1:1-3; Acts 3:19-20; Matthew 5:13]

The church should not be ineffective.

2. I Got This [3:17-18; Hosea 12:8; Deuteronomy 8:11-19; 2 Thessalonians 1:11; 2 Corinthians 3:14-18; Isaiah 55:1; John 7:37]

The church should not be indendent of God.

3. Someone is at the Door [3:19-22; Hebrews 12:5-6]

The church should not be insubordinate.
