

THE GOSPEL

THE CENTER OF EVERYTHING WE DO AT HIGHLANDS

GOD: The only all-knowing, all-powerful King and Creator of all things. He created us to enjoy and glorify him forever. [Psalm 19:1-2; Romans 1:18-32]

God keeps his covenant promises to his true people.

3. The Multitude [7:9-17; John 16:33; Isaiah 1:18; John 6:35]

God provides for his true people with his presence.

Big Idea: God enables his true people to stand.
